Minutes of Meeting  
March 12, 2008

The March meeting was called to order at 5:15 PM, March 12, 2008. Those in attendance were Tiffany Marsh, Barbara Atwood, Kay Shanker and Teresa Lewis.

1. WHHS achieved third place in the recent chamber choir competition at UofL.
2. Kyle Lawrence and Sarah Lewis attended the ACDA conference in Louisville and represented WHHS well. Next year's conference will be in Oklahoma City.
3. There is a girls' chorale competition Saturday, March 15.
4. The annual choral banquet will be held Thursday, May 1. Kay Shanker will check with Immanuel Baptist to see if we can hold the banquet there. Teresa Lewis will look into BBQ and the cost. Gifts for seniors were also discussed.
5. Chorale and chamber choir will perform at Graefenburg United Methodist morning service on March 30, as well as the May 3 Derby breakfast.
6. A trip to King's Island has been planned for Saturday, May 17. The cost per student, using Bluegrass Tours coach, will be \$68, which would also cover chaperone costs. Mrs. Marsh will confer with Mr. Hale to see if we'd like to coordinate this trip with the Academic Team. At least two chaperones will be needed.
7. Mrs. Marsh is looking into an extended trip for chorale for the 2008-09 school year. There will be approximately 40 students in chorale. She is also looking at a January 2009 trip to see Wicked at the Kentucky Center for the Arts, hoping to have a backstage tour and maybe opening this trip to the Drama Club as well.
8. Kay Shanker presented the treasurer's report, showing available cash of \$4,051.57. The new posture chairs and riser flooring have been paid in full.
9. Candy sales ended February 26. With Modern Woodmen matching our efforts, there will be an approximate profit of \$2,000. Kay will cut a check to MW for the amount of our profit, and they will reimburse us that, along with their matching amount. The MW representative, Larry Milburn, will be asked to attend the banquet to formally present the donation.
10. March is "Music in Our Schools" month. There will be a music assembly March 28. There will be a daily question in homeroom with drawing for a prize, and band and chorus boosters are asked to assist with that expense, approximately \$50 each. This was approved.
11. We would like to switch out the metal step cover for a black rubber step cover for the new riser flooring. Todd Ellis is checking into this for us and will get back with us with the additional cost.
12. The kids really like the new posture chairs. The old chairs have been removed.
13. Regarding sound panels, a work order has been submitted. We need to get an estimate from a company supplying them. Mrs. Marsh will speak with Mr. Hancock to ask for building money to be used to purchase.
