

Western Hills High School
Choral Department Booster Club
Minutes of Meeting
April 15, 2008

The March meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM, April 15, 2008. Those in attendance were Tiffany Marsh and Barbara Atwood.

1. One candy box was stolen from practice room. Mrs. Marsh suggested no credits be given to students due to the theft. Barbara disagreed saying the booster club will eat the loss.
Also, it was suggested that Larry Milburn of Modern Woodmen make the official presentation of the matched funds to the Western Hills Chorus Booster Club at the May 1st banquet.
2. Approved the Booster Senior Scholarship Form for students who will be majoring or minoring in music in college. This is one \$250 scholarship recognized at the chorus banquet.
3. Derby Breakfast performance for Advanced Chorale has been set for 9:00 a.m. at the Capitol Stage. Students need to report at 8:15 a.m. It is suggested that students park at the Cabinet for Human Resources building and shuttle to the Capitol.
4. Ice Cream Concert is Thursday, May 15th. We will need parent help to serve ice cream following concert. We will ask different ensembles to bring different items such as: bowls, toppings, spoons, napkins. Ice cream will be purchased and donated by Barbara.
5. Chorale King's Island trip has two parent chaperones currently. In need of two more.
6. Barbara said the additional \$70-\$75 cost for the rubber stair nose would be alright. Mrs. Marsh will contact Todd Ellis to add that. Barbara's husband will install flooring this summer.
7. Mrs. Marsh proposed the payment of 3 instrumentalists for a mini mass composition that Chorale is performing at the May 22nd concert. The proposed amount is \$300 per player. This would be for 2 rehearsals and 1 performance. Barbara agreed with this payment. Mrs. Marsh said she will send out an email to get overall approval from other booster officers.
8. Mrs. Marsh expressed an interest in purchasing attire for the Girls' Chorale for the 2008-2009 school year. It will be the same attire as the girls in Advanced Chorale. Mrs. Marsh will get number of outfits needed and approximate cost for presentation at the May booster meeting. Barbara added that it would be a good idea to send an end of the year letter to parents with information including attire purchase/rental.
9. At the May booster meeting we will be voting on 2008-2009 booster officers. The following positions will need to be filled: Vice President, Banquet Chair, Attire Chair. Mrs. Marsh will send emails to other parents asking for interest.
10. The 2008-2009 chorus fundraisers will be finalized at the May booster meeting. Suggested or requested fundraisers: Sponsorship Program?, Magazine with Readers Digest in the fall (August – to begin school, maybe with Bondurant?), Candy Sales (twice; once in fall, once in spring), Rock-A-Thon with Band (check into and find

- date from Mrs. Wallace). Paperwork will be filled out in preparation for the the May booster meeting.
11. Two issues will be placed on the May agenda due to lack of attendance to make a decision at the April meeting. These items include: Registration payment (reimbursement) for student involvement in programs such as ACDA and KMEA, and Liability insurance (Barbara said she can call on and Mrs. Marsh said she could contact Jennifer True).

 - Flooring
 - Attire for Girls' Chorale
 - 2008-2009 booster officer vote
 - 2008-2009 Fundraisers
 - Registration reimbursement
