Choral Department Booster Club
Minutes of Meeting
September 25, 2007

The September meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm. September 25, 2007. Those in attendance were Tiffany Marsh, Barbara Atwood, Kay Shanker, Teresa Lewis, Linda Snell, Tracy Badgett and Sandie Lawrence.

1. Fundraisers—Barbara stated that students were given magazine sales packets today, and the campaign will run through October 15. Student accounts will receive 20% of sales. It was decided that if 20 students in Advanced Chorus sell 10 or more subscriptions, the name of each student who sells 10 or more will be placed in a drawing for a free trip to Orlando in March 2008. If a student sells 20 subscriptions, his/her name will go in twice.
2. Student Accounts—Kay will try to have updated student account statements to Tiffany shortly.
3. Fall Concert—The fall concert will be held in the cafeteria on Tuesday, October 16 at 7 p.m. In Barbara's absence, Teresa will give welcome/announcements.
4. Attire—Tiffany stated responses to attire rental/purchase have been good, as she has commitments one way or the other from most all students. Attire fittings will be Tuesday, October 25. Some students have asked to use their accounts for attire rental fees.
5. Spring trip—Students will depart for Orlando on March 13, missing only one day of school (excused). To keep individual costs down, the booster club agreed to finance the bus driver's hotel room and the \$100 Festival Disney registration. A payment schedule will be established and published, the first payment being due at the end of October.
6. Major Purchases/Expenses
 - Posture chairs—Barbara stated she's been practically guaranteed that the school board will pay for half of the chairs if the booster club pays half. It was decided to await a written commitment.
 - Riser flooring—Tracy Badgett reported that the Endura product would cost \$1692, plus adhesive, for 564 square feet. The Roppe product is a little cheaper, at a total cost of about \$1,500. Tiffany clarified the purpose of the riser flooring is to protect the risers structure and deaden sound. Barbara suggested that we go ahead and order the cheaper product and hopefully have it installed over fall break. It is the consensus of the group to proceed with the Roppe product. Tracy will have her brother, Todd Ellis, come to measure the area for specific dimensions.
 - Regarding the sound panels/asbestos letter to the school, Tiffany has the letter and hopes to review it over fall break.
7. Treasurer's Report—Kay presented the treasurer's report, showing a checkbook balance of \$9,169.22, of which \$7,570.10 is available cash.
