Choral Department Booster Club  
Minutes of Meeting  
November 13, 2007

The October meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM, October 23, 2007. Those in attendance were Tiffany Marsh, Kay Shanker, Linda Snell, Teresa Lewis and Barbara Atwood.

1. The candy sales will be held in February. We must sell \$2,500 so that we can take advantage of the \$2,500 match. Modern Woodmen require that the match be designated for a specific purpose, which will be our half of the classroom set of posture chairs.
2. Mrs. Marsh noted that the Choral Department is heavily involved in this year's Miss WHHS Pageant and has asked the sponsors to share a cut of the proceeds with the Department. That request, however, has been denied. Those students giving effort (ushers) can instead use their service for Tri-M or Beta points.
3. Attire
  - Mrs. Marsh noted that all attire orders are here and will be distributed this week.
  - Mrs. Marsh has decided to allow Girls' Chorale to wear black pants and white shirts. The Booster Club will therefore refund attire rental fee to those girls either via check or as a credit to their student account.
4. ACDA Honor Choir—Kyle Brumley, Kyle Lawrence, Sarah Lewis and Amit Shanker were accepted for ACDA Honor Choir.
  - There has been a parent request to pay the \$175 registration fee. After a lengthy discussion, it was decided that as long as the Booster Club had the available funds and there were no more than four students accepted each year, the Booster Club would make it a policy to pay the \$175 registration fee for any student who worked hard and was accepted by the ACDA
  - Teresa Lewis has volunteered to chaperone all four kids and asked that the Booster Club pay for her hotel stay, which was agreed to.
  - Tiffany will approach Mr. Hancock about paying her \$80 registration fee as part of her professional development. If that is denied, the Booster Club will pay the fee.
5. All-State Chorus—Tia Ashby, Kyle Brumley, Kyle Lawrence, Sarah Lewis, Amit Shanker and Aneatria Whaley made All-State Chorus. It will be held February 6-8, 2008 in Louisville. Teresa Lewis volunteered to be girls' chaperone if no one else is willing. As with ACDA, the Booster Club will pay chaperones' hotel fees.
6. Moving the Booster Club meeting time to 5:30 was discussed, but it was decided to keep the time at 5:00 p.m.
7. Major Purchases/Expenses
  - Riser flooring—Tiffany reported that Carpet Outlet is quoting us their cost for the materials, which is \$1,668 plus \$117 for an edge covering. This price does not include the underlayment, which they recommend.
  - Mr. Hancock has responded that the sound panels/adhesive will be tested in the near future.

- Charlie Preston confirmed that the Board in Spring 2008 will pay one-half, \$2,500, of the cost of posture chairs.
8. Treasurer's Report—Kay presented the treasurer's report, showing a checkbook balance of \$11,214.36, of which \$8,300.00 is available cash. The \$8,300 reflects \$1,400 student account liability, approximately \$800 for magazines and \$700 for new attire.
