Minutes of Meeting  
May 15, 2007

**Meeting** called to order at 5:10 pm.

Those in **attendance**: Tiffany Marsh, Debbie Slattery, Kay Shanker, Jennifer True, Barbara Atwood, Ed Lawrence and Sandie Lawrence.

May 17th is the choral department's **Ice Cream Concert** which will be held at 6:30 p.m. (students there at 5:30) in the auditorium. Things needed: Kim Smith will collect ice cream toppings at 5:30 from students, Carolyn Slone will sell candy prior to concert at 6:00, Ed Lawrence will take pictures, Jennifer True will purchase ice cream, bowls, spoons, napkins. Barbara mentioned that she has a houseboat cooler for future use. Barbara Atwood suggested taping the auditorium door to minimize disruptions during concert. Tiffany Marsh will do this prior to concert beginning.

**Choral Banquet update**: Saturday, May 19th at 6:00 at Immanuel Baptist on Collins Ln. Reservation lists will be given to Jennifer True and Kay Shanker. It was decided that no tickets will be passed out; as long as Kay has a list of names at the door to check off people who reserved space. Tiffany Marsh asked Jennifer if she had spoken with the caterer regarding a vegetarian lasagna. Jennifer stated that she simply purchased a vegetarian lasagna at the grocery to be backed. She also said she needs to know which students will be needing the vegetable option. Jennifer True said that the gathering room has a sound system, a piano can be rolled in and there is a wall for projection of the video. Jennifer True said she would be at Immanuel Baptist around 4:00, so that Mrs. Marsh can arrive early to set up. Jennifer also mentioned that people should park on the right side of the church and enter there.

Barbara suggested that the treasurer's report define what amount is tied up in student accounts and what is in the general fund. Other members agreed that this would be a good addition.

Tiffany Marsh agreed that this would be a good thing to do; this will give an opportunity to answer any questions parents may have and also pass out fundraising items such as the Kroger card.
