Minutes of Summer Planning Meeting  
Tuesday, September 9, 2008

The summer planning meeting was called to order at 5:15 PM, September 9 at Western Hills High School. Those in attendance were Tiffany Marsh, Barbara Atwood, Kay Shanker, Eileen Hardy.

1. REVISE BYLAWS
  - A. Motion made by Eileen Hardy to change and seconded by Kay Shanker
  - B. Action of retype and amend:

The WHHS Choral Booster Club Bylaws were distributed, and officer term lengths and duties were discussed. It was decided to delete Article V, Section 1(c), which reads "A person shall not be eligible to serve more than 2 consecutive terms in the same office."

At the end of Article VI, Section 3, first paragraph, the verbiage "The Treasurer position shall be bonded" is to be added. At the end of Article VI, Section 4 (which is not numerically identified but the paragraph between Section 3 and Section 5), the verbiage "An audit shall be performed in July at least biannually" is to be added. However, final action was not taken on these changes, and this issue will be re-addressed at the September meeting.

  - B. New Orleans with band is questionable due to cost of trip.
