M2 - Mastering Musicianship

Statistics indicate that if a child participates in music, he or she is likely to earn higher grades and score better on standardized tests. Now there is powerful scientific evidence of a cause and effect link between music instruction and intelligence.

Western Hills Chorus' Mastering Musicianship Program, M2, will provide individual vocal music lessons over a 10-week session each semester. The advantages to this program are cost and convenience. The rate for private lessons in Frankfort or Lexington is approximately \$15-25 per half-hour, or more. The M2 program at Western Hills is only \$10 per half-hour lesson (\$100 for the 10-week session) and the private instruction takes place in the practice rooms of the Western Hills choir room, under the direction of highly qualified music consultants.

Lessons are arranged to accommodate student needs and availability of the vocal instructors. The majority of the lessons will occur between the hours of 3:30-8:30 pm, Monday thru Thursday. The tentative fall lesson schedule is below.
