Write an informative/research paper on a medieval topic of your choice. You must include detailed information on the topic. For the paper to be accepted, citations and a bibliography must be included (See attached form on bibliographic citation).

Your topic will need to be submitted by <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 29</u>, but can be submitted earlier. Once a topic is claimed <u>it cannot be repeated by another student</u>. Please turn in the bottom of this paper with a 1st and 2nd topic choice.

For your writing assignment, consider you audience, development of your ideas, organization, appropriate sentence structure, grammar, word choice, and punctuation. Please do more than one draft of this paper. You may submit a draft to Mrs. Marsh for review, but it is not required. Draft quality work is not accepted for the final product. Please refine this work prior to turning it in.

Your paper must be **at least two pages** in length, **typed**, **single-spaced** in a **12-point traditional** font. If you have pictures to support your topic and want to include them in the paper you must add them <u>on separate pages at the end of the paper</u>. This writing assignment is worth 100 points.

You must include a separate bibliography page with this paper and a **minimum** of two sources in correct bibliographic form (see attached). Parenthetical documentation or footnotes must be used throughout your paper. Your sources may consist of Internet (**NOT** Wikipedia), book, article, encyclopedia.

This assignment is due: <u>Tuesday, October 19^{th} .</u> – **NO** late submissions.

There will be a formal presentation of your researched topic. More information on the presentation will come later. Presentations will begin on Tuesday, October 19th.
