Piano Class Program Notes

You are to write a program note for each of your two spring recital pieces. A program note is a written sample that explains to the audience the piece they are about to hear.

Things to include:

- Background information on the composer
- History of the song
- General information about the composition such as: key, length of composition, use of hands, etc.
- **SEVEN (7)** music elements must be addressed on how they are used throughout the piece: melody, harmony, rhythm, tempo, meter, dynamics and form.

Since your program note will be written for publication our spring recital program, the writing should be in with appropriate grammar and punctuation. Ensure your writing is professional. Consider your audience and ensure it has appropriate language, form, and content. A bibliography of sources MUST accompany your notes.
